Assistant Visual Arts Instructor

This position is responsible for support and collaboration with the visual arts director on instruction, curriculum planning, implementation, mentorship, and performance/showcase planning for 30 students at our 2-week long, summer arts program. Instructors live on-site at Willamette University throughout the program. A typical daily schedule includes: 5 instructional hours, production meetings, instructional preparation time and evening showcases/performances.

Other duties:

- Collaborate with other instructors across various artistic disciplines
- Guide one or more youth counselors who will also serve as teaching assistants
- Teach an elective class in any subject you wish (does not have to be arts based)
- Be a part of the camp community including camp meals, performances, activities, and more.

Skills and Qualifications:

- Established career and competence in arts subject matter
- Experience teaching youth, across various ages and ability levels
- Understanding of classroom management
- Ability to assist with curriculum planning for the 2 week program
- Ability to assist with planning multiple performances/showcases
- A desire to integrate into an all-immersive arts experience with an open mind and flexibility

YMA's mission is to provide young people with a unique personal experience in the visual and performing arts, where they share creative interest in a positive environment that builds confidence, enhances self-esteem and reinforces a sense of community. Dates of commitment: July 6th - July 19th, 2024. Several pre-planning Zoom/phone meetings with Camp Director and Counselors are also required.

Compensation: This is a contracted position with a \$2000 stipend, plus all meals and housing.
